

**Board of Directors Meeting

December 13, 2008**

Call to order: 8:05am

Motion made by Corky Meyer, second by Laura Huber, to approve up to \$300 for Ruth Ann Lee, on behalf of the Education Committee, to fix the education trunks. Motion carried.

Motion made by Rick Lazarczyk, second by Ken Barbian, to approve funding for Jack Nissen to stay overnight in Stevens Point, WI to attend Conservation Congress meeting on December 19, 2008. Motion carried.

Motion made by Larry Laehn, second by Rick Lazarczyk, to approve funding for Ralph Fritsch to stay overnight and food to be able to attend State Wildlife Annual Meeting and for funding for food for a joint committee meeting between the Forests, Parks and Recreation and Wildlife Committees.
