Resolution to Create a Permanent Class A and Class Disabled Permit

- Whereas, the Wisconsin Wildlife Federation and the Department of Natural Resources are deeply committed to supporting the active participation in hunting and fishing by citizens with disabilities;
- Whereas, the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources currently issues initial Class A and Class C permits for a 5-year period and issues renewal permits for a 10 year period;
- Whereas, citizens issued a Class A Disability Permit have a permanent or irreversible physical disability;
- Whereas; Citizens issued a Class C Disability Permit have a permanent or irreversible visual disability;
- Whereas, the proposed administrative modifications will reduce the Department of Natural Resource's time and expense administering the Disability Permits;
- Whereas, the proposed administrative modifications is customer-service oriented, by reducing paperwork and travel/expenses for Disability Permit applicants and physicians/chiropractors/optometrists;
- Whereas, the proposed modifications will enhance Disability Permit monitoring in the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources;
- Resolved, that the Wisconsin Wildlife Federation at its 2014 Annual Meeting, April 11-12, 2014 in Wisconsin Rapids, Wisconsin supports the followed resolutions regarding administrative modification of the Class A and Class C Disability Permit process:
 - (1) The elimination of the current 5 year initial permit and 10 year renewal permit process for Class A and Class C Disability Permits;
 - (2) Based on a properly-completed Disability Permit Application, the issuance of a PERMANENT Class A and/or Class C Disability Permit; and
 - (3) The Recording of the PERMANENT Class A and/or Class C Disability Permit Number onto the DNR Customer database and print said Disability Permit Number on all fishing/hunting licenses issued in the Permanent Disability Permit holder.
